Study Environment in the Library

A. POLICY STATEMENT:

The CCRI Library aims to provide a suitable space for research, study, library instruction, and reading. In order to maintain such an environment:

- 1. Cell phones should be switched to quiet mode and used outside the library.
- 2. Food and/or drink are allowed in designated areas only.
- 3. Pets, other than service animals, are not allowed in the library.
- 4. Disruptive and/or threatening behavior is not allowed.
- 5. Library staff members may request that individuals be quiet or move to avoid disturbing other library users.

B. DEFINITIONS:

- 1. Disruptive and/or threatening behavior includes, but is not limited to, excessive noise, sexual harassment, and other actions not conducive to maintaining an environment for research, study, library instruction, and reading.
- 2. Library staff members Full time library staff and librarians

C. PROCEDURES:

- 1. When disruptive and/or threatening behavior occurs, or if a patron reports a behavior problem to the library, a library staff member will investigate. The person(s) involved may be asked to be quiet or move by the library staff member.
- 2. Library staff members may contact Campus Police for assistance.

D. POLICY APPLIES TO:

All library users

E. EXCEPTIONS:

All exceptions to this policy must be approved by the Dean of the Library.

F. RESPONSIBLE DEPARTMENT:

The Library will implement and maintain this policy.
