WHO TO CONTACT IN THE EVENT OF A SEXUAL ASSAULT

Reporting a sexual assault to the Campus Police is procedurally the same as reporting to one of the local or state law enforcement agency in the State of Rhode Island. Victims have the same rights when reporting to any local law enforcement agency.

Depending on which campus the incident occurs, we will notify local law enforcement to proceed with the case.

Off campus services include the **Women's Center 401-861-2760** and **Rape Crisis Center @ 401-421-4100**, both are available 24 hours 7 days a week.

The personnel in these offices can provide advice and counseling, detailed information on health issues and reporting procedures, or referrals to resources off campus.

Confidence in these matters is maintained except when either the security of the campus or the surrounding community is breached. These Campus Police Offices are opened 24 hours 7 days a week.
