ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE (A.S.) DEGREE

The Web Site Development program is designed for individuals who wish to pursue a career in microcomputing and acquire the training necessary to prepare them for a position specifically in Web site development. It is also ideal for those wishing to gain a broader knowledge of computer software and/or hardware.

Important: Students must obtain a grade of at least “C” in all computer course requirements and must maintain a 2.0 GPA.
