PROGRAM OVERVIEW

SCHEDULE

Kids' College will be offered in two sessions, July 20 to 24 and July 27 to 31. Students may attend one or both sessions. The daily schedule runs from 9 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. Monday through Friday. Students will attend two, 90-minute classes each day. The first class runs from 9 to 10:30 a.m. A snack will be provided from 10:30 to 10:45 a.m. and the second class is scheduled from 10:45 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.

New this year, in an effort to enhance each camper's experience and allow individual choices, students are asked to rank their class preferences on the registration form. Every effort will be made to grant first-choice options; classes will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Written confirmation of your session and class schedule will be sent either through mail or e-mail. If your class is canceled due to insufficient enrollment, the college will give you the option to enroll in another class or refund your fee.

TUITION RATES

The cost per one-week session is \$140. Parents/guardians are responsible for providing students with transportation to and from CCRI Kids' College. Additional children from the same family are eligible for a reduced fee of \$125. Each two-week session is subject to the \$5 registration fee.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Officially withdraw from Kids' College by calling Rebecca Paglia at 401-825-2033. Refunds will be calculated as follows:

- Thirty days prior to the start of your session you will receive a full refund, less a \$50 processing fee.
- We are unable to grant a refund with less than 30 days notice prior to the start of the session.



Session 1: Class Descriptions

ART ADVENTURE: Calling all aspiring artists! Come explore studio fundamentals of drawing, painting, designing, working with color and more. You will work on several projects that will fuel your creative process. This is your opportunity to bring your skills to a new level in an encouraging atmosphere. No prior experience is necessary.

BODY BUILDING: What is blood pressure? How long is your small intestine? What is a headache? Uncover fascinating facts as you build your body; no, not with weights but through conducting hands-on experiments. You'll add body parts and systems to a life-size model of yourself as you discover the many wonders of the human body

CHAA-CHING — STARTING YOUR OWN BUSINESS: Turn your bright idea into a money-making reality. When starting a business there are tricks of the trade that everyone should know. Explore topics such as how and where to advertise, what businesses will work in your area and how to get the skills you need to succeed. Design fliers, business cards and other things important to any successful enterprise.

DESIGN YOUR OWN BOARD GAME: You get to decide the object of the game, the number of players and make the rules. Here's a chance to bring a great game idea to life or create one if you've never thought of the idea before. Want to play? The session will conclude with a day of trying one another's games.

MAKE A MOVIE: Lights, camera, action ... make a movie! You can be the researcher, writer, editor and even star in your very own film as you learn to use Windows-based movie-making software. Look out, George Lucas and Steven Spielberg: There's a new producer in town.

Session 2: Class Descriptions

THE ART OF SELF-DEFENSE — AN INTRODUCTION TO MARTIAL ARTS: Enhance your strength, flexibility and balance while improving your timing and reaction skills. Our instructor holds three black belts, a black sash and will introduce you to various non-contact striking forms (punching and kicking). Self-defense techniques and danger awareness will be incorporated throughout. No experience is required.

ART ADVENTURE: Calling all aspiring artists! Come explore studio fundamentals of drawing, painting, designing, working with color and more. You will work on several projects that will fuel your creative process. This is your opportunity to bring your skills to a new level in an encouraging atmosphere. No prior experience is necessary.

EXPLORE SPACE: Learn about Earth, the moon and other bodies in our solar system as we talk about space travel, re-enact the first step on the moon and design a moon colony. We'll also create a model of our solar system and build a rocket. Blast off!

LET'S ACT UP: Lights, camera, action! Want to be an actor or actress? Here's your chance. Learn some basics of stage acting, improvisation, theater terminology, speech and movement. Focused theater exercises and games will generate creative ideas as actors prepare scenes and monologues.

PICTURE PERFECT: Improve that less-than-perfect photo or turn a favorite digital photo into a work of art. Learn the magic of Adobe Photoshop software: Discover editing techniques; transform and combine images; apply color effects; use filters and more. If you like, bring a CD with pictures of people and/or animals to use in your projects (not required.)
