The college's Knight Campus in Warwick is home to the Bobby Hackett Theater, which is named after a professional musician who formed the Harvard Gold Coast Orchestra to play at colleges around New England. The theater is one of the largest community theater spaces in the state and is where our music, theater and arts students perform and display their talents. Community groups also use the space for a variety of programs.
