

## *Faculty Characteristics*

In the fall of 2001, there were 299 continuing, full-time faculty members at the Community College. For this group, the most frequent set of characteristics was holding a master's degree, being a full professor, and having been with the Community College for 15 or more years. Forty-eight percent of all full-time faculty hold the rank of full professor.

CCRI also employs many part-time adjunct faculty members primarily to teach evening courses. Approximately 436 adjunct faculty helped the college meet the instructional needs of more than 16,000 students during the fall 2001 semester. Statistics on the adjunct faculty are not included in these charts and tables.
