

Student Financial Aid



The total financial aid dollars from State and Federal sources increased over this reporting period. State dollars were up by 3.5 percent and Federal dollars increased by 11 percent from 1998-1999 to 2000-2001.

Students qualifying for State program awards from RIHEAA increased 8.1 percent and Student Help increased by 6.4 percent while Community College Grants decreased by 5.7 percent from fiscal 1999 to fiscal 2001. At the Federal level, the dollar value of Pell Grants awarded increased by 13 percent.
