

Incoming Students

All incoming students who attended an orientation session offered for entrance in the spring or fall of 2001 completed a Student Information Sheet. Data collected from these students provide us with descriptive, historical information useful in a variety of planning processes within the Community College. A total of 2,044 students completed the information sheet with 1,339 students or 65.5 percent under 20 years of age.

Students were also asked if they would be employed while attending CCRI. Eighty-nine percent responded yes. Of this group, approximately 83 percent indicated they would be working over 10 hours per week.
