Center for Training & Development

The Center for Training and Development conducts customized training programs as well as on-site credit programs custom designed to meet the needs of business and industry as well as many public sector service industries. Courses are offered at the Community College, business and industrial sites, community centers, Quonset Training Center, and other convenient locations. These enrollments consist of credit and non-credit customized programs. They reflect an increase in training income of 102% for the twelve month period. Welding training and computer training are currently offered at temporary facilities in the Quonset Davisville Park.
