The student body at the Community College of Rhode Island enjoys considerable diversity in age, culture and experience. Sixty-two percent are women, 66 percent are part-time students, and 48 percent are 25 years of age or older. Over 16 percent of students report they are from a minority group.

For the fall of 2001, students in the under 20 age group account for 21 percent of the headcount enrollment. Of this age group, 72 percent are full-time students. Also, our Official Enrollment Report for Fall 2001 indicates that 22 students are actually foreign students from 13 different countries.
