

## Plan to attend the Spring 2012 JAA Days

Students enrolled in JAA are **required** to receive advising from a CCRI advisor and a URI or RIC advisor each semester. By attending JAA Days, you will fulfill this requirement.

JAA students transitioning to RIC for the **Fall 2012** semester must make an appointment to meet with Dolores Passarelli ([jaa@ric.edu](mailto:jaa@ric.edu) or 456-8083) on the RIC campus.

- JAA students are strongly encouraged to meet with a CCRI advisor **before** JAA Days so that you will only need to obtain advising from RIC or URI during JAA Days.
- To proceed directly to the RIC or URI advisors on JAA Days after check-in,
  1. Meet with a CCRI advisor prior to JAA Days by scheduling an appointment or attending Walk-in Advising Hours.
  2. Bring to JAA Days
    - your Education Plan (courses for Fall 2012) from Advising and Counseling,
    - a recent degree evaluation, and
    - an unofficial transcript.

To access these documents, log on to your **My CCRI** account and click on the *For Students* tab. For **Degree evaluation**: Click on Registration Tools and then on Degree Evaluation, select the term, 'Detail Requirements' and click on submit. For **Unofficial Transcript** scroll down to the Academic Profile box and then click on transcript and select submit. Print both documents; **the degree evaluation should be printed in landscape**. If you need assistance, directions are available at the Advising and Counseling Center or Office of Enrollment Services.
