General Education Requirements

The Therapeutic Massage program is an integrated program, with one 7 credits of prerequisite coursework, followed by 12-months of program coursework and general education coursework. There is a recommended sequence for students who choose to complete the general education courses during the program, and the estimated program costs outlined herein are reflective of this recommended sequence. The general education courses may, however, be taken at any time prior to being accepted to the program. The total program cost may vary for students who choose a different option for completing the General Education courses.

Prerequisite Courses

Prior to acceptance into the Therapeutic Massage program, the following courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. They may be taken at any campus, day or evening.
