General Education Requirements

The Therapeutic Massage program is an integrated program, with one semester of prerequisite coursework, followed by I6-months of program coursework and general education coursework. There is a recommended sequence for students who choose to complete the general education courses during the program, and the estimated program costs outlined herein are reflective of this recommended sequence. The general education courses may, however, be taken at any time <u>prior</u> to being accepted to the program. The total program cost may vary for students who choose a different option for completing the General Education courses.
