This email is going out to all NURS 1020 students on the Knight, Flanagan, Liston and Newport campuses. I hope you all had an enjoyable holiday season and got some much needed rest. Now it's time to get ready for a new semester so you can get closer to your goal of becoming a Registered Nurse.

I will also be sending you the NURS 1020 Math Track. You will see that you will be having an IV Lab within the first week of school. I will be sending you the IV Lab objectives plus IV Lab assignments. You will have your Math Test # 1 in the second week of school. If you get an 85% or better on your test you will not need to take any other Math Tests in NURS 1020. Yahoo!!! Start your studying now.

We are just about ready to put students into the clinical groups where they will have their NURS 1020 hospital experience. I was hoping that everyone registered for NURS 1020 would have up to date health records, gotten updated PPDs and all have an updated CPR card. However, I have just found out that several students who are registered are no longer up to date. I am finding that many students who had met the requirements are now considered NonCompliant because they did not submit verification of receiving the Flu Vaccine or the Waiver Form if they chose not to receive it. Therefore, these students will not be able to be given a clinical spot in NURS 1020. If you are not eligible for a clinical placement then you can not take NURS 1020. Please complete these health requirements ASAP to be included in the Spring 2009 class of NURS 1020.

Get your info in ASAP to Health Services in Warwick. They can answer any and all questions about your health record. Do not send your explanations or excuses to me or the secretaries. Do not ask secretaries to fax your information. You need to make sure your health data arrives at the Health Services Office. This is your responsibility. Only Health Services is authorized to access and update your records.
