### To Apply

If you are a **new degree or non-degree student** please submit an Application for Enrollment located in the CCRI Catalog or on the CCRI Web page: [www.ccri.edu/catalog/application.pdf](http://www.ccri.edu/catalog/application.pdf). On section 4 of the CCRI Application for Enrollment, you should apply to General Studies as your first choice and the health science program of interest as a second choice. If you are currently enrolled in a degree or certificate program and/or have earned credits at a college you previously attended, please submit an official college transcript from that college to the Flanagan Campus at 1762 Louisquisset Pike, Lincoln, RI 02865. Students transferring credits to meet PBHS program requirements must plan ahead, as the transfer process may take several weeks to complete. ### Admission Notifications

You will be notified about **conditional acceptance** through your MyCCRI email account. The conditional acceptance letter will include information about a mandatory background check that must be completed within 10 days. If you choose not to complete this process within this time period, your application will not be considered for this acceptance period. Students who successfully complete the background check will be notified of their **official acceptance** through their MyCCRI email account. You must confirm your official acceptance within 7 days using your MyCCRI email account. If you do not confirm your official acceptance within this time period, your application will be withdrawn. If you are not admitted based on the performance-based admission criteria, you must reapply during the next open application period.
