SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABLE

The Greenwich Bay Women's Club, a community service organization, is now accepting applications from residents in the East Greenwich, Warwick, and North Kingstown areas for its annual scholarship award. Priority will be given to applicants from those communities who have been involved in community service and who desire to attend or return to an accredited institution to continue their education. The number of scholarships and amounts vary each year; the funding comes from two major fundraisers we hold. In recent years we have awarded scholarships, ranging from \$500 to \$1,000, to high school graduating seniors and even a returning college student. Awarding of the scholarship is based on community service; grades are not a consideration.

The deadline for applying for this scholarship is April 1, 2017. I have enclosed a copy of our application. Please feel free to make additional copies as needed for others who would like to apply.

This is a one-time award and previous recipients are ineligible for consideration. However, previous applicants may resubmit an application.

Please make sure applications are filled out COMPLETELY and ALL REQUESTED INFORMATION is attached. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

TO THE APPLICANT: This application must be received by the Greenwich Bay Women's Club no later than April 1st, 2017. All questions must be answered completely. The information you provide on this application will be held in the strictest confidence (only the chairman has list of names). Applicants may be subject to an interview with the Scholarship Committee. You must begin to use any scholarship monies awarded within twelve months. Proof of enrollment must be provided.

The applicant **must** include the following with the application:

1. Three (3) letters of recommendation from individuals personally acquainted with your community service activities. **NOT GENERAL GUIDANCE LETTERS. Relatives are excluded.**
2. A brief paragraph describing your reasons for becoming involved with community service.
3. A summary describing your community service activities, including organizations, specific projects, and dates of service.
4. A brief paragraph describing your career goals, indicating your intended major (if you have decided) and how you plan to achieve your degree and goals.

***We do not need your grades as they do not determine eligibility.**
