### High School Seniors & College Students & Professionals

- A. PURPOSE OF THE FUND:** To aid Rhode Islander residents who require financial assistance in the pursuit of education within the building industry field. Students must be a resident of Rhode Island attending an in-state or out-of state school.
- B. WHO IS ELIGIBLE?** Any Rhode Island Resident who is unable to provide full tuition payment while pursuing education in the building industry is eligible.
- C. TYPES OF COURSES:** Students: Courses in pursuit of an Associates, Bachelors or Certificate programs are eligible. Full or part time programs are eligible.  
Professionals: Professional Society Seminars, construction related courses to enhance current skills or to develop new skills. Full or part time programs are eligible
- D. AMOUNT OF AID:** Varies: maximum award \$4,000.
- E. WHEN AID IS AVAILABLE:** Fall Semester 2017. Aid is provided directly to your college; invoice submission required if selected.
