Who Can Receive Services? All student Veterans, Active Duty, and Dependents attending CCRI or RIC can access the Department of Veterans Affairs through a full time VA Coordinator.

What type of services are available?

- Guidance and support with your education benefits
- Vocational exploration and assistance in selecting a suitable career / major
- Electing your healthcare benefits with Veterans Healthcare Administration
- Accessing, understanding, and applying for VA benefits (i.e. Disability Compensation, Life Insurance, Education, Home Loan Guaranty, and Vocational Rehabilitation)
- Referrals for medical and mental health
- Referrals for readjustment counseling services for eligible Veterans and their families
- Coordinating with school faculty/staff to provide Veteran specific services (i.e. VA Certifying Official, Career Center, Student Disabilities Services, Counseling Center)
- Job placement assistance and coordination with Local Veterans’ Employment Representatives (LVER) and Disabled Veterans’ Outreach Program (DVOP)
- Locating community and other resources
