
FOR SPRING 2023: Online Student Rating of Instruction (SRI)


SRIs are open for all modalities and parts-of-term the day following the drop period of late-start courses and will remain open until the last day of class: **February 27, 2023 – May 5, 2023**

Student Rating of Instruction (SRI) is available on the CCRI web portal. Faculty now may log on to their **MyCCRI account** to Web Enable evaluations. **Do not use Blackboard (Bb).**

- Click on the "For Faculty" tab
- Toggle to the bottom of the screen where you will see, "Faculty Admin Tools"



- Click on "Enable Online Evaluations"; it is the last item in the Faculty Admin Tools
- Then, Select a Term; in this case, Spring 2023.... December 27, 2022 May 17, 2023; hit submit
 Select Term



- A list of the faculty course(s) for the Spring 2023 term will appear
- To enable your course(s), check the "Web Enabled" box of each course

Enable Online Evaluations



To track student responses, check your class roster. After three (3) students have completed the course SRI, indicators in the "Eval" column will populate -- "N" for No <u>or</u> "Y" for Yes – for each student.
