 - Involvement in community service activities.

PROCESS:

- Submit a completed application.
- Submit a 200-300 word essay highlighting your contribution toward the criteria listed above, supported by documentary evidence and/or personal references.
- Submit a Letter of Support/Recommendation from an organizational representative to support your essay.
