Emphasis is placed on operating principles of hardware and software, networking models, operating systems, internetworking components, industry standards and hands-on laboratory activities for developing practical problem-solving skills. Students develop the ability to configure and troubleshoot basic PCs. Courses that prepare the student to sit for both the Comp TIA A+ and the MCITP exams are integrated into the program.
