Blending online study with face-to-face lab instruction

CCRI's **Local Anesthesia for the Registered Dental Hygienist (DHYG 2200)** provides a comprehensive study of local anesthetics used in the dental profession. This course blends online pre-study with 15 hours of face-to-face lectures, and 16 hours of lab instruction. A minimum of 20-30 hours of time will be required for the Blackboard online component, which begins March 19, 2018 and must be completed by May 25, 2018. Upon completion of the course, you will be awarded two college credits, or the equivalent of 30 CEU's.
