



Emergency Grant Application

Summary of program: The CCRI Emergency Grant helps students who are facing an unexpected financial emergency that is creating a barrier to continued college enrollment and completion. The Emergency Grant helps with expenses such as books, educational supplies, food, transportation, housing, daycare, medical expenses and other unforeseen costs. Funds are limited in availability, and eligible students will be reviewed on a rolling, first-come, first-awarded basis.

To be considered, a student must:

- Be enrolled at CCRI on or after March 13, 2020
- Have completed the 2021-2022 FAFSA or demonstrate financial need.
- *Note: Funding may be available for students who are ineligible for federal financial aid or unable to file a FAFSA, but demonstrate financial or an emergency need.

Please note, the Emergency Fund is not a long-term solution for financial difficulties. It is a one-time form of assistance when no other solutions are available.

Your grant will be refunded by the Bursar’s Office, unless you have provided authorization to allow CCRI to pay outstanding tuition, fees and book charges (below). If you have not already signed up for e-refunds, <https://www.ccri.edu/bursar/e-refund.html> please do so to allow the grant to be direct deposited in your bank account. Otherwise, you will be mailed a check, these are processed weekly.
