FAFSA Workshop Appointment Checklist

Be sure to have the following information available for the workshop:

- FSA ID (<https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm>)
 - Dependent students, at least one parent needs to create an FSA ID
 - Parent and student must use different email addresses and phone numbers
 - For students, use personal email, not a school email address
- Student's Federal Income Tax Return (including schedules)
- Student's W2's, 1099's or form Schedule C
- Parent's Federal Income Tax Return (including schedules)
- Parent's W2's, 1099's or form Schedule C
- Parent's social security number, date of birth, marital status and date.
(dependent students only)
- Amounts of any additional income received such as child support, social security, welfare benefits, etc.
- Eligible non-citizens – permanent resident card

For enrollment in **Fall 2021**

* The **2021-2022** FAFSA requires **2019** income information

For enrollment in **Spring & Summer 2021**

* The **2020-2021** FAFSA requires **2018** income information
