The following pathway will fulfill a 2+2 transfer agreement in Business Accounting between the Community College of Rhode Island and Castleton University. A 2+2 program is defined as a successful completion of the courses outlined for both institutions with a grade of C- or higher. This will ensure that candidates will obtain a Bachelor of Science in Accounting upon completing the remaining credits at Castleton. Candidates who wish to pursue a Masters in Accounting will also be eligible to continue into Castleton's 30-credits Master of Science in Accounting Program, provided all prerequisites have been fulfilled for the program.
