One Undergraduate Program. Three Great Options.

1. Enroll in the **Undergraduate Evening Online Program** after earning an Associate's Degree
 - Take evening online classes at a reduced rate.
 - Complete a BSBA with concentrations in Accounting, General Business, Human Resources Management, Management, or Criminal Justice Management.
 - For some students, Federal and State grants and loans will leave **zero** out-of-pocket expense
2. Enroll as a **full-time commuter student** after earning an Associate's Degree
 - Enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours each Fall and Spring semester
 - Students pay a reduced rate per semester.
 - Access the full catalog of Nichols programs and services: 19 majors and concentrations
 - For some students, Federal and State grants and loans will leave **zero** out-of-pocket expense
3. Enroll as a **full-time resident student** after earning an Associate's Degree
 - Enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester
 - The tuition, room and board rate are reduced by an ABLÉ scholarship
 - Access the full catalog of Nichols programs, as well as the convenience of on-campus living
 - For some students, Federal and State grants and loans will cover *most* of the remaining tuition, room and board expenses, leaving little out-of-pocket expense

These options make Nichols College among the most transfer friendly private colleges in New England.
