Blackboard Technical Skills

The Distance Learning policy requires familiarity with Blackboard to teach online. This document outlines a series of tasks that faculty should be confident in their ability to complete independently and be aware of the impact those tasks have on the student experience.

This list includes commonly used tools and tasks for online courses based in Blackboard. It is adapted from the Faculty Technology Readiness list and developed in coordination with the Instructional Support team and the Online Learning office.

The list is in two parts – tasks that all online faculty should be familiar and those dependent upon your course design and the use of any other online tools, such as publisher websites.

- Grade submissions (Assignments, Tests, Discussions)
