STUDENT GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS

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REQUIREMENTS TO RUN FOR PRESIDENT

The following requirements must be met in order for you to run, and must be maintained during your term:

- 1 Must have and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA
- 2 Must be in and remain in good disciplinary standing
- 3 Must run on the campus of record as indicated in your student record
- 4 Must maintain and pass a minimum of nine credits per semester
- 5 Must be able to perform all duties and responsibilities as outlined in Section 8-7A of the CCRI Student Government Constitution.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF PRESIDENT

Each Campus President has a number of duties and responsibilities to complete, including, but not limited to:

- * Chair their campus Executive Committee
- * Preside over meetings of the campus Senate
- * Appoint members of the campus Executive Committee
- * Authenticate all acts, resolutions, and orders of the campus Student Senate
- * Represent the student body and Student Government to the administration of the Community College of Rhode Island whenever the need arises

NOVEMBER 12	Campaign Agreement Meeting Thursday, November 12th at 12:00pm-1:00pm This meeting is <u>mandatory</u> for all approved candidates. If you cannot attend, please make note of that on your application.
NOVEMBER 12	Campaigning begins
NOVEMBER 17	Campaigning ends
NOVEMBER 18	Voting opens Votes will be collected by electronic ballot.
NOVEMBER 19	Voting closes Elected candidates will be notified via email by November 20.
NOVEMBER 23	Elections results announced

APPLICATION INFORMATION

After thoroughly reviewing this packet, you'll need to gather some information in order to apply:

- * Your Student ID and CCRI Email Address
- * Your Primary Campus
- * A thorough review of this application packet and the full list of President responsibilities in the Constitution
- * A list of any extracurricular activities or leadership experiences you have had, either at CCRI or off-campus
- * How your skills and experiences that would help you in the role of campus President
- * An idea of who you might want to appoint for your Cabinet (not required, but encouraged!)
- * A brief platform of why you're running and your vision for Student Government (about 250-300 words total)
