

Credit for Prior Learning

CLEP Process for HMNS 2100

The CLEP: Human Growth and Development has been reviewed by CCRI ECE faculty and approved as an equivalent to HMNS 2100 – Child Growth and Development Skills. However, HMNS 2100 contains the two Key Assessments below, which are required of each student for the program’s NAEYC accreditation.

Key Assessment 4: Infant-Toddler Observation and Developmental Profile

Key Assessment 5: Preschool Observation and Developmental Profile

Students who wish to pursue Credit for Prior Learning through the CLEP exam above must also complete the two Key Assessments above.

Steps/sequence for students wishing to move forward with this option:

1. Register and take the CLEP
 - a. Registration steps are available at <https://www.ccri.edu/advising/clep/>.
 - b. When registering, be sure to indicate CCRI as a score recipient.
 - c. Passing scores will be sent to CCRI Records and posted as a GENS 0000 Elective.
2. Contact Courtney Read at ecread@ccri.edu to coordinate your completion of the two Key Assessments.
3. Upon successful completion of the Key Assessments, the Human Services department chair will coordinate with CCRI Records to have the HMNS 2100 credit posted.

An alternate option for students to earn Credit for Prior Learning is through *Portfolio Assessment*. The two Key Assessments are required for this option as well.
