The Rhode Island Promise Scholarship allows 2018 Rhode Island high school graduates who are under age 19 at the time of graduation to pursue an associate degree at CCRI tuition free. This scholarship may also be awarded to students who graduate from high school at age 19, 20 or 21 due to personal circumstances that delayed their high school graduation. This supplemental application is required in order for CCRI to determine your eligibility for the Rhode Island Promise scholarship.
