Each kind of sentence (**TS**, **A**, **T**, **N**, and **G**) appears only once in each activity.

- e) <u>A</u> This essay is going to tell a story about animals in pet stores.

- b) <u>N</u> I hate the small size of my closet.
- c) <u>T</u> Organization in a Closet
- d) <u>G</u> If you look into people's closets, you will see many different items.
- e) <u>A</u> My closet will be described in this paper.
